Talking book machines are available from John McIntire Library free of charge for Nursing Home residents.

Talking Book machines allow persons with visual or physical limitations to listen to books.

Applications for Talking Book machines are available from the library by contacting Extension Services. We process the completed application and deliver the machine once the application is approved. Tapes for the machines may be borrowed, free of charge, through the Cincinnati Library for the Blind. However, the machines have two speeds, which make it possible for residents to listen to Talking Book tapes as well as audio book cassettes available from your Muskingum County Library System.

You may already have Talking Book machines at your location. If you currently have Talking Book machines that are in need of repair, please let us know. We will gladly provide a replacement machine and return the broken machine for repairs.

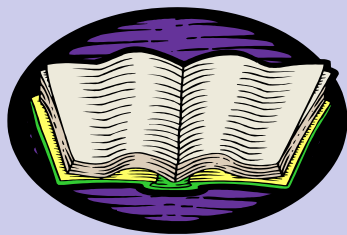
